Privacy Policy - SET-JET25 - The World Screen Tourism Summit

This privacy policy sets out how the organisers of The World Screen Tourism Summit (The Tourism Business) uses and protects the information we collect. The Tourism Business (registered with the UK ICO) is the data controller and data processor of any personal data you supply. Any personal information provided will be used to process your event booking and ensure you have the best possible event experience.

What we collect

The Tourism Business and its event registration company, Mosaic Events, may collect the following information:

- your name and job title
- your contact information, including your email address and phone number
- personal information such as special requirements both dietary and mobility
- demographic information such as postcode, preferences and interests
- other information relevant to your attendance at the event (such as an address for invoicing purposes)

What we do with the information we gather

The Tourism Business and its event registration company, Mosaic Events require this information to understand your needs and provide you with a better service. We may use this information in the following ways:

- perform or take steps to enter a contract to attend an event
- improve our event offer and services
- send emails about information which is relevant to attending an event
- customise the website registration pages according to your interests
- from time to time, we may also use your information to contact you for market research purposes related the event you have signed up for, or for an allied event run by The Tourism Business, and we may contact you by email, SMS, or mail
- If you request to receive no further contact from us, we will keep some basic information about you on our suppression list in order to comply with your request and avoid sending you unwanted materials in the future.

Who has access to your information?

The Tourism Business and Mosaic Events' staff have controlled access to your information to enable us to provide you with services. We may pass your information to our third-party service providers, subcontractors and other associated organisations to provide services on our behalf. The organisation we work with to host our event management software is Cvent, a global conference company with its own strong privacy policies.

By signing up to one of our events you have **OPTED IN** to allow your data to be used for marketing, statistical and analytical purposes and to administer your booking(s).

With event communications, consent can be withdrawn at any time by contacting us or by using the link in the relevant email.

Controlling your personal information

How we use cookies
